

During this summer term our topic is 'Seaside'. This term we are focusing on Geography and we will be learning about maps and compass directions.

Reception have been very busy this week.

In RWI we have learned a new sound , start the car 'ar' and read our green storybook Ned the dog. Next week we are going to recap all of the set 2 sounds which we have learned so far and do a new green story book called Six Fish.



We are also trying hard to read the new red word

'they' and write the red word 'you'.

In MMS we have been acting out our maths stories with the cups and writing them down in our books. We have also been counting up to 99. Next week we will be using decimetre sticks to make shapes, practicing the formation of our digits and learning that the same quantity of cups can be represented in different ways.

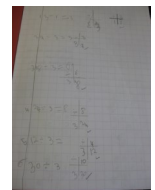
Years 1 & 2 have had a busy 1st week back !

This week in English group 1 have been reciting poems . We have been focusing on kennings in poetry. Next week we will be moving on to writing our own poetry.



Group 2 have been recapping all sounds they have focused on last term. They have been writing instructions and stories linked to dressing up. Next week they will be applying their phonic knowledge to sentences.

In MMS year 1 and 2 have been measuring accurately using mm, right angles and writing Maths Stories in multiplication and division grid. Next week they are moving onto looking at multiplication as the inverse of division, creating grids and subtraction using funny counting!



FS/KS1 whole-class In Re we have been looking at special books the children brought their special books in as well as looking at sacred texts from different religions.

Art work we have nearly finished our dioramas and we are now moving onto creating a character using clay to go into the dioramas.

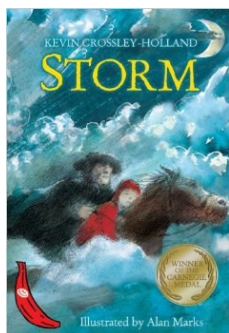
For Geography this term we will be looking at creating maps, using keys , following directions using maps and compass



During this summer term our topic is 'Seaside'. It is a geography-based topic and we will be learning about rivers and coasts with a focus on the local area.

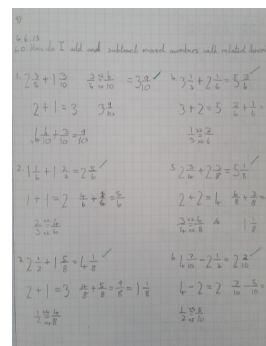
## Years 3 & 4

After a lovely week off Year 3 and 4 have come back ready to go! In English they have been writing persuasive leaflets about visiting Cornwall and have done a great job! They have included lots of persuasive features including rhetorical questions and fabulous adjectives to catch the reader's attention. In Maths we have been learning about a variety of things. Some of us have been reading, writing and ordering numbers with 2-decimal places. Others have been finding halves and quarters of amounts, while others have been adding and subtracting tens and hundreds to a wide range of numbers. Next week in English we are starting a new Power of Reading book called 'Storm' by Kevin Crossley Holland which is a ghost story! In maths we will be looking at multiplication and division by scaling recipes up and down.



## Years 5 & 6

In Maths, we have been doing some fantastic fractions. We have found equivalent fractions; converted mixed numbers to improper fractions and vice versa; added and subtracted fractions and mixed numbers with different denominators and we have all survived! In English we have been working on information leaflets for the next year groups in September. These contain much useful advice. Next week in maths, we are looking at formal methods of multiplication and division. We will also be designing a room for a fictional character by scaling 'real-life' measurements. We will continue with a range of writing which links to our book about Whales. We will be writing reports, letters and arguments.



## KS 2 whole-class

In science we have worked on separating materials using sieves, next week we will be using heat to try and separate materials and deciding if changes are reversible or irreversible. In topic we have started to look at coasts and located towns and cities with coastlines. We will continue to identify features of the coastlines and investigate coastal erosion. D&T has seen us design beach huts which we will make using a timber frame and clay in the coming week.
