


This term our topic is 'Chocolate' We will be exploring chocolate in all of our subjects.

In RE we made our own Sukkah huts in the class room to finish our topic of harvest and being thankful .




During this Autumn term our topic is 'Chocolate'. In History we will be learning about the Maya and creating our own chocolates in D&T.

**KS 2 whole-class** We have had a very busy week in the juniors this week! Mrs Smith, Mrs Combe and Mrs Noble have played the part of Lord Alan Sugar in our 'Chocolate Apprentice Week'. All of KS2 were split into teams of 4 and have been learning and developing skills involved in designing, creating and producing their very own chocolate product, complete with chocolates, chocolate box and radio advert! To start the week the children thought carefully and planned who they wanted their target audience to be. They then went on to plan ideas for names, logos, flavours and boxes. After lots of discussion they began to create their boxes using their knowledge of 3D shapes, experimenting



with polydron and practicing drawing and constructing nets of shapes. Once happy with their design they used Textease on the computers to design their logos. They had to think carefully about colour choices, sizing and how to use the shape tool to best effect. They printed these ready to decorate their boxes. Next the children needed to think carefully about how to advertise their chocolate products and they decided a radio



advert would be a good idea. In their groups they used musical instruments to create and record a jingle. They then added persuasive language and information to create the final advert. Finally it was time to produce the chocolates and on Friday morning the children added different ingredients to melted chocolate and poured it into moulds ready to package.



To finish off the project each group presented their final chocolate product to the teachers. The children have worked really well this week and have used many cross-curricular skills effectively, including how to work successfully as part of a group! Well done and have a lovely half term.
